Why: Healing of the Canoe is different from other conferences. Our goal is for the people in your organization that will be facilitating the curriculum to youth, to gain experience with role playing, curriculum development and ideas for engagement.

When: November 6 - 9, 2023. Attendees will be given access to registration on July 19, 2023 and registration must be completed by October 20, 2023

Where: Training will take place at Clearwater Casino Resort in Suquamish, WA. Hotel rooms will be available until October 5, 2023 at Clearwater Casino Resort. For room reservations, view booking details below under "I've registered, now what?"

Who: We highly recommend attendees be those who will be facilitating the curriculum to the youth in your community and those who will be adapting your curriculum. At Healing of the Canoe, we call them facilitators, but you may call them teachers. The people who will adapt your curriculum will be crucial as well.

What: This conference will be specific to your needs for your curriculum and your community. We recommend that you come prepared with ideas

for cultural activities, speakers, leaders in your community that you may want to participate in the curriculum in some way, and willingness to work in a group with your team.

Price: Register by September 4, 2023 to receive the early bird special of \$1,600. Registration between September 5 - October 20, 2023 pricing will be \$2,100.

What's included with my conference ticket?

- 4-day conference training with ratio of 10 attendees to 2 trainers
- Breakfast, Lunch and Afternoon Snack all 4 days
- One night of cultural sharing and dinner
- Welcome Bag
- Course materials

What meals are included during the conference?

- Breakfast, Lunch and afternoon snack will be provided during conference days
- Dinner will be on your own. With the exception of the cultural sharing night where Healing of the Canoe will provide dinner.

How do I get to Clearwater Casino Resort?

You will need to provide your own transportation to Clearwater Casino Resort. We strongly recommend renting a car. This will make traveling to and from the resort easier. A rental car will also give more opportunities to explore the peninsula. From downtown Seattle take the Washington State Ferry to Bainbridge Island.

Once off the ferry, Suquamish is a short 15-minute drive.

What is Cultural Sharing?

One night during the conference we will have a dinner that includes cultural sharing. We ask that organizations bring a song, dance, traditional food, storytelling, craft, or anything about your organization to share with the group during the cultural sharing night. Details regarding cultural night will be on your conference agenda.

What is the weather like this time of year?

In Seattle Washington, every day is a surprise. It might be dry, rainy, sunny or all three. It will definitely be chilly at night and a little warmer
